

NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119

THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (FOOTPATHS 005 AND 008 CHICHELEY AND 015 EMBERTON) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2018

The above Order was made on the 18 December 2018, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980. The effect of the Order will be as follows:-

To divert part of the existing Public Footpath 005 Chicheley running from point A at O.S Grid Reference SP90861 46880 in a generally south-westerly direction for approximately 120 metres to point B at O.S Grid Reference SP90782 46783 then continuing in a generally west-south-westerly direction for approximately 165 metres to a culvert at point C at O.S Grid Reference SP90632 46721 as indicated on the Order map by a bold red continuous line, to a line running from point A at O.S Grid Reference SP90861 46880 in a generally south-westerly direction for approximately 280 metres to point C at O.S Grid Reference SP90632 46721, indicated on the Order plan by a bold black dashed line. The surface of the new way shall be arable cross-field, with a width throughout of 1 metre and a length of 280 metres.

To divert part of the existing Public Footpath 008 Chicheley running from point D at O.S Grid Reference SP90767 47160 in a generally north-easterly direction for approximately 180 metres to the junction with Chicheley Footpath 006 at point E at O.S Grid Reference SP90914 47261 continuing in a generally north-north-easterly direction for approximately 290 metres to point F O.S Grid Reference SP91107 47475 then continuing in a generally north-north-easterly direction for approximately 260 metres to point G at O.S Grid Reference SP91213 47714 where it terminates at the junction with Emberton Footpath 15, as indicated on the Order map by a bold red continuous line, to a line running from point D at O.S Grid Reference SP90767 47160 in a generally north-easterly direction for approximately 130 metres to point I at O.S Grid Reference SP 90843 47264, then continuing in a generally south-easterly direction for approximately 75 metres to point E at O.S Grid Reference SP90914 47261 continuing in a north-north-easterly direction for approximately 90 metres to point J at OS Grid Reference SP90960 24736, then in a north-easterly direction for approximately 140 metres to point K at OS Grid Reference SP91040 47442, continuing in an east-north-easterly direction for approximately 80 metres to point F at OS Grid Reference SP 91107 47475, then in a generally northerly direction for approximately 165 metres to point L at OS Grid Reference SP91134 47634, then continuing in a generally northerly direction for approximately 93 metres to terminate at a sleeper bridge at point M at OS Grid Reference SP91150 47725, indicated on the Order plan by a bold black dashed line. The surface of the new way shall be an arable field-edge path between points D-I-E with a width throughout of 1.8 metres, then a hard surfaced farm track between points E-J-K-F with a width throughout of 3.5 metres, then an arable field-edge path between points F-L with a width of 1.8 metres and then as a cross-field route between points L-M with a width of 1metre, terminating at a sleeper bridge. The route has a length of approximately 773 metres.

To divert part of the existing Public Footpath 015 Emberton running from point H at OS Grid Reference SP91149 47730 in a generally easterly direction for approximately 66 metres to point G at O.S Grid Reference SP91213 47714 at its junction with Chicheley Footpath 008 as indicated on the Order map by a bold red continuous line, to a line running from point H at OS Grid Reference SP91149 47730 in a generally southerly direction for approximately 5 metres to point M at OS Grid

Reference SP91150 47725 indicated on the Order plan by a bold black dashed line. The surface of the new way shall be an existing bridge consisting of 2 sleepers and a width of 50 centimetres.

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the Milton Keynes Council, Civic Offices, 1 Saxon Gate East, Milton Keynes between 9.00am and 5.00pm on any working day, also at Milton Keynes Library, 555 Silbury Boulevard, Milton Keynes, during normal opening hours. Copies of the Order and map may be purchased from the Civic Offices at the price of £3.00.

Any representations about or objections to the Order together with the grounds on which they are made must be made in writing and sent to the Head of Legal Services, Milton Keynes Council, Civic Offices, 1 Saxon Gate East, Milton Keynes MK9 3EJ to be received no later than 21 January 2019, quoting reference PE-WL-019422-PDO.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
