HIGH STREET FOOTPATH – The uneven surface of the footpath in the High Street was first reported to Milton Keynes Council in January 2012 with the parish council being notified on several occasions that it did not meet the criteria for repair. After much perseverance and a visit from the highways manager, the parish council is pleased to report that the footpath has now been resurfaced.

VILLAGE NAME SIGNS – The parish council has received an estimate from Ringways to replace the three Emberton signs, two on the A509 and one in Newton Road. It is hoped that the project will be part funded by a grant from Milton Keynes Council.
